THE REFERRAL BENCH of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

BEING SEIZED OF the Prosecutor's Motion of 29 November 2004 for referral of the present case

by a Trial Chamber under Rule 11bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules") to the

State of Bosnia and Herzegovina, after having given, if it deems necessary, the opportunity to the

authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina to be heard on the Motions and on the conditions for the

referral of this case;

NOTING the Referral Bench's "Decision for Further Information in the Context of the

Prosecutor's Motions under Rule 11bis" dated 15 April 2005 ordering the Parties and inviting the

Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to submit their views on the gravity of the crimes and the

level of responsibility of the Accused, as well as on the substantive and procedural law that would

be applicable to the case should it be referred to the government of Bosnia and Herzegovina;

NOTING that Counsel for the Accused has raised no objections to the hearing in this case being

held at the same time as the hearing in the case of Prosecutor v. Mitar Rašević and Savo Todović,

Case No.: IT-97-25/1-PT for reasons of efficient administration of justice;

PURSUANT to Rules 11bis and 74 of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULES A HEARING to commence on 12 May 2005 at 14.15 in a courtroom

designated by the Registry;

INVITES the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to attend the hearing and, should it wish, to

present additional oral submissions.

REQUESTS the Registrar to transmit this order immediately to the Government of Bosnia and

Herzegovina.
