**PURSUANT** to Rules 54 and 98*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”);


**HEREBY ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) shall close its case no later than Wednesday 1 June 2005;
2. The Trial Chamber shall immediately move to apply the procedure set forth by Rule 98*bis* of the Rules pursuant to which:
  - a. The Defence shall have the opportunity to present its oral submissions on Thursday 2 June 2005; and
  - b. The Prosecution shall thereafter have the opportunity to present its oral submissions on Friday 3 June 2005.
