**TRIAL CHAMBER II** ("Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

**NOTING** that Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules") provides that a party shall file a final trial brief not later than five days prior to presenting a closing argument;

**CONSIDERING** that Rule 86 of the Rules also provides that after the presentation of all the evidence the Prosecutor and the defence may present a closing argument;

**NOTING** the hearing on 19 May 2005;

**RECALLING** Rule 87 of the Rules;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

**PURSUANT** to Rule 86 of the Rules,

**ORDERS** the parties to file their final trial briefs not later than 4 July 2005. The Prosecutor shall present her closing argument on 11 and 12 July 2005; the Defence for Enver Hadžihasanović shall present its closing argument on 12 and 13 July 2005 and the Defence for Amir Kubura on 14 July 2005, and

**ORDERS** that pursuant to Rule 87 of the Rules the hearing shall be declared closed following the closing arguments on behalf of Amir Kubura.
