THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

NOTING the “*Urgent Appeal of Trial Chamber’s Decision on Length of Defence Case*,” filed by Naser Orić (“Accused”) on 6 July 2005 (“Appeal”);

NOTING the “Order Varying Time Limits for Filings in Interlocutory Appeal,” issued by the Appeals Chamber on 7 July 2005 (“Order”), in which the Prosecution was given until 11 July 2005 to respond to the Appeal;

CONSIDERING the Prosecution’s oral request on 11 July 2005 to extend the deadline for their Response until 12 July 2005 on the grounds that one of the Prosecution attorneys is ill;

NOTING that the Trial Chamber was in session on 11 July 2005 and that the Prosecution has not requested a stay at the Trial Chamber;


CONSIDERING the short deadline necessitated by the exceptional circumstances of this interlocutory appeal’s impact on the rights of the Accused, as discussed in the Order;

HEREBY ORDER that the deadline for the Prosecution’s Response is extended until noon on 12 July 2005;

AND FURTHER ORDER that the Accused must file any Reply it chooses to make by noon on 14 July 2005.
