NOTING the Acting President's Order of 18 March 2005 assigning the case to Trial Chamber I;

between the parties, to review the status of the case and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise

issues in relation to his mental or physical conditions;

PURSUANT to Rules 54, 65 bis and 65 ter;

HEREBY ORDERS that a Status Conference be held on Wednesday 24 August 2005 at 14h15 in

Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and that the Parties be ready to discuss the status of

the case.
