**NOTING** that Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal provides, *inter alia*, that “[a]fter the expiry of the time-limits for filing the briefs provided for in Rules 111, 112 and 113, the Appeals Chamber shall set the date for the hearing.”;


**CONSIDERING** that the filing of the briefs in the Appeals is complete;
