THE REFERRAL BENCH of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

BEING SEIZED OF the "Request by the Prosecutor under Rule 11bis for Referral of the

Indictment to another Court" dated 19 July 2005 seeking referral of the present case by the Referral

Bench under Rule 11bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules") to the authorities of

Bosnia and Herzegovina, after having given, if it deems necessary, an opportunity to the authorities

of Bosnia and Herzegovina to be heard on the Request and on the conditions for the referral of this

case;

NOTING the Referral Bench's "Decision for Further Information in the Context of the

Prosecutor's Motions under Rule 11bis" dated 5 September 2005 ordering the Parties and inviting

the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to submit their views on the gravity of the crimes and

the level of responsibility of the Accused, as well as on the compatibility of the legal system of

Bosnia and Herzegovina with Rule 11bis;

NOTING that Counsel for the Accused has raised no objections to the hearing in this case being

held at the same time as the Rule 11bis hearing in the case of Prosecutor v. Ivica Rajic Case No.:

IT-95-12-PT for reasons of efficient administration of justice;

PURSUANT to Rules 11bis and 74 of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULES A HEARING to commence on 20 September 2005 at 14.45 in a

courtroom designated by the Registry;

INVITES the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to attend the hearing and, should it wish, to

present additional oral submissions.

REQUESTS the Registrar to transmit this order immediately to the Government of Bosnia and

Herzegovina.
