**SCHEDULING ORDER FOR MEETING
PURSUANT TO RULE 65ter (I) OF THE RULES**

I, WOLFGANG SCHOMBURG, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

NOTING that in the last status conference on 6 September 2005, the Pre-Appeal Judge convened

a Rule 65 ter (I), 107 meeting, [...] together with one representative of the Registrar to take minutes from this meeting [...] to discuss how to proceed in this case and, in particular, all the medical aspects but not limited to this. (“Rule 65ter(I) Meeting”);¹

CONSIDERING that both parties agreed to have a Rule 65ter(I) Meeting in week 41;²

CONSIDERING that the Defence of Pavle Strugar informed the Pre-Appeal Judge and the Prosecution that it would prefer to discuss Pavle Strugar’s medical issues in the privacy of the Rule 65ter(I) Meeting;

CONSIDERING that the Defence for Pavle Strugar informed the Pre-Appeal Judge that the assistance of B/C/S–English and English–B/C/S translation services during the Rule 65ter(I) Meeting would be required;

PURSUANT to Rule 65ter(I), Rule 107 of the Rules

HEREBY ORDER that the Rule 65ter(I) Meeting be held before the Pre-Appeal Judge on 11 October 2005, at 14.00 p.m. in Room 177;

INVITE the Parties to address the health situation and its possible consequences on the appeal proceedings;


DIRECT the Registrar to provide for B/C/S–English and English–B/C/S translation services and to appoint a representative of the Registry who shall take notes of the Rule 65ter(I) Meeting.
