NOTING the Order of 5 April 2005 issued by the Presiding Judge of the Trial Chamber pursuant to

Rule 65ter of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal ("Rules")

designating me as the Pre-Trial Judge in the case of Prosecutor v. Ljube Boškoski and Johan

Tarčulovski;

CONSIDERING the possibility that this case could come to trial sooner than planned in which

case the Trial Chamber has the responsibility to ensure that the trial could start at short notice;

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 66 (A)(ii) and Rule 65ter (E) and (F) of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDER** 

(a) The Prosecution to make available to the Defence in a language which both accused (Ljube

Boškoski and Johan Tarčulovski) understand, copies of the statements of all witnesses

whom it intends to call to testify at trial no later than 31 October 2005;

(b) The Prosecution to submit its Pre-Trial Brief, the list of witnesses and the list of exhibits to

be tendered at trial no later than 31 October 2005; and

(c) The Defence to submit its Pre-Trial Brief no later than 28 November 2005.
