NOTING the “Order Designating Pre-Trial Judge” filed on 10 November 2005,

NOTING that Sredoje Lukić (the “Accused”) made an initial appearance on 20 September 2005,

NOTING Rule 65 *bis*(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), which states that a “Trial Chamber or a Trial Chamber Judge shall convene a status conference within one hundred and twenty days of the initial appearance of the accused”,


NOTING the previous “Order Scheduling a Status Conference,” which was filed on 28 November 2005 and scheduled a status conference in this case for Thursday, 15 December 2005, at 2:15 P.M.,

CONSIDERING that counsel for the Accused has indicated that he is unable to attend the conference on 15 December 2005,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 65 *bis*,

HEREBY VACATE the “Order Scheduling a Status Conference” filed on 28 November 2005, and **ORDER** that a status conference shall take place on Wednesday, 18 January 2006, at 8:00 A.M.
