I, MOHAMED SHAHABUDEEN, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Order Assigning Judges to a Case Before an Appeals Chamber,” filed on 14 February 2005, which, *inter alia*, designated me to serve as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

NOTING that Trial Chamber I rendered its Judgement in this case orally on 17 January 2005 and in writing on 24 January 2005 (“Judgement”);

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seised of notices of appeal filed by Vidoje Blagojević and Dragan Jokić (“Appellants”) and by the Prosecution;

NOTING that the Appellants are in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague during the appeals proceedings in this case;


NOTING that the most recent Status Conference in this case was held on 23 September 2005, and that the next Status Conference should, according to Rule 65 *bis* of the International Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence, be held within 120 days after that date, namely on or before 21 January 2005;

NOTING that, however, counsel for Mr. Jokić has notified the International Tribunal that certain family concerns will make her unable to attend a status conference by that date, and has requested that the conference be postponed accordingly; and

NOTING that both Appellants have agreed to waive their right to a status conference within 120 days of the last conference in order to accommodate that request;

ORDER that a Status Conference be held on Monday, 20 February, 2005 at 8:00 AM, in Courtroom 2 of the International Tribunal.
