I, Jean-Claude Antonetti, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

HAVING BEEN DESIGNATED as pre-trial Judge pursuant to the Order rendered by Trial Chamber II on 31 October 2005;

NOTING the proceedings of the latest status conference held on 30 January 2006;

NOTING Rules 65 ter(B) and (I) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");

CONSIDERING that it is in the interests of justice and an expeditious preparation for trial to take measures on what was expressly stated at the last status conference and to draw up a schedule;

HEREBY ORDER as follows:

- the Prosecution shall file as soon as possible, and no later than 20 February, copies of all the exhibits and witness statements it intends to tender at trial, together with <u>an</u> <u>index</u> of all the said documents;¹
- the Prosecution is hereby granted a new extension of time-limit so that it may submit by <u>14 April 2006</u>, in electronic format, an updated version of its lists of witnesses and exhibits filed on 19 January 2006 pursuant to the orders of 30 November 2005 and 24 January 2006;
- a meeting chaired by the pre-trial Judge shall be held on 16 February 2006 at 09:00 hours with all the parties involved in the trial² and with the Accused Praljak by video-conference from Zagreb should he not be assisted by counsel;
- 4) the Registry shall make all necessary arrangements for setting up the videoconference link.

¹ The Trial Chamber will not consider these documents as evidence as long as they have not been tendered and admitted during the proceedings.
