

THE CHAMBER, in the interests of the proper administration of justice,

HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. A housekeeping session in the presence of the Accused shall take place on the morning of Thursday 23 February 2006. Should one of the parties prefer a delayed start on that morning, it is invited to email the Chamber's staff.
2. Both parties are invited to email the Chamber's staff with any items they wish to have included in the agenda for the housekeeping session on 23 February.
3. The Defence case is to recommence on Monday 27 February 2006. The session is currently scheduled for the morning, but if the afternoon session is preferred by the Defence due to the Accused's inaccessibility over the weekend, the Defence is requested to email the Chamber's staff about this without delay.
4. The Chamber is informed that the Defence case is to recommence with the testimony of Mr Krajišnik. His testimony in chief shall last a maximum of four weeks, namely till Friday 24 March 2006, on the outside. The Chamber notifies the Defence that the Chamber shall closely monitor the questions put to – and the responses given by – the witness in this period, and that the Chamber may, in order to optimize the receipt of relevant evidence within the time-constraints of this case, readjust the amount of time provisionally granted hereby to the Defence for the examination-in-chief of Mr Krajišnik.
