I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

**NOTING** the Indictment in *The Prosecutor v. Milan Lukić, Sredoje Lukić and Mitar Vasiljević*, filed on 28 October 1998, and the Amended Indictment, filed on 12 July 2001;

**NOTING** that the Registry has informed the President of the Tribunal that Milan Lukić ("Accused") will be delivered to the seat of the Tribunal on 21 February 2006;

**CONSIDERING** that no Trial Chamber is currently seised of the case against the Accused;

**NOTING** that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal authorizes the President of the Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

**CONSIDERING** the trial management and case distribution needs of the Tribunal;

**HEREBY ASSIGN**, effective upon the arrival of the Accused to the seat of the Tribunal, the case against the Accused to Trial Chamber III.
