I, IAIN BONOMY, a Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991,


NOTING Milan Lukić's initial appearance, on 24 February 2006, at which he pleaded "not guilty" to all counts against him in the Amended Indictment,

CONSIDERING the "Decision Granting Prosecution's Motion to Amend Indictment with Regard to Milan Lukić," filed on 22 March 2006, which makes the Second Amended Indictment the operative indictment against Milan Lukić, and which states that "a further appearance before Judge Bonomy, at which Milan Lukić will be asked to plead to the counts against him in the Second Amended Indictment, will be scheduled in due course by Judge Bonomy,"¹

PURSUANT TO Rules 50(B) and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

ORDER that a further appearance, at which Milan Lukić will be asked to plead to the counts against him in the Second Amended Indictment, shall be held at 9:00 A.M. on Friday, 31 March 2006.
