I, Judge Patrick Robinson, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber III of the International Tribunal for

the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law

Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING the Indictment in the case Prosecutor v. Milan Lukić, Sredoje Lukić and Mitar Vasiljević,

filed on 28 October 1998, and the Amended Indictment, filed on 12 July 2001,

NOTING that the initial appearance of the Accused Sredoje Lukić took place before Judge Iain

Bonomy on 2 June 2003, and the initial appearance of the Accused Milan Lukić took place before

Judge Bonomy on 13 June 2003, at which time they pleaded not guilty to all counts of the

Indictment,

NOTING the further appearance of the Accused Sredoje Lukić on 13 February 2006, and the

further appearance of the Accused Milan Lukić on 31 March 2006, at which time they pleaded not

guilty to the new charges in a Second Amended Indictment against them,

CONSIDERING the two Orders issued by the President of the Tribunal on 12 May 2006,

assigning Judges Krister Thelin and Frank Höpfel to Trial Chamber III for the purposes of pre-trial

work in the present case,<sup>1</sup>

**CONSIDERING** Rule 65ter(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules"),

which provides that the Presiding Judge of the Trial Chamber shall "designate from among its

members a Judge responsible for the pre-trial proceedings" (hereinafter "pre-trial Judge"),

HEREBY ORDER that Trial Chamber III in the case Prosecutor v. Milan Lukić and Sredoje Lukić

shall be composed, for the purposes of pre-trial proceedings, as follows:
