NOTING the Rule 65 *ter* Conference held on 17 May 2006, at which I verbally made several orders pursuant to my authority as Pre-trial Judge in this case,

CONSIDERING the usefulness of enumerating those orders in writing,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54, 65 ter(B) and 65 ter(K) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDER as follows:

- the Defence teams shall file, by 22 May 2006, any motion(s) for the modification of the conditions of provisional release regarding the Summer 2006 Tribunal recess. The Prosecution shall file, by 29 May 2006, any response to the Defence motion(s);
- (2) the Prosecution shall file, by 26 May 2006, its motion to tender exhibits from the bar table and for the Trial Chamber to take judicial notice of evidence from other proceedings pursuant to Rule 94(B). The Defence teams shall file, by 19 June 2006, any response(s) to the Prosecution's motion;
- (3) the Prosecution shall file, by 14 June 2006, a submission identifying as far as possible (a) the evidence likely to be led at trial during the week of 10 July 2006 and (b) the witnesses likely to be called from the start of trial through the end of August 2006;
- (4) the Defence teams shall file, by 15 June 2006, any response(s) to the Prosecution's motion to admit written evidence pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*, which is due by 26 May 2006;
- (5) the Prosecution shall file, by 6 July 2006, a submission identifying the Rule 70 witnesses it intends to call, and shall also disclose the statements of those witnesses to the Defence teams;
- (6) the next Rule 65 ter Conference shall be held on 21 June 2006.
