Liubiša Beara, Drago Nikolić, Ljubomir Borovčanin, Zdravko Tolimir, Radivoje Miletić, Milan

Gvero, Vinko Pandurević and Milorad Trbić, Case No. IT-05-88-PT;<sup>1</sup>

NOTING Rule 65bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules") which

provides, inter alia, that a status conference shall be convened within one hundred and twenty days

after the last status conference to i) organise exchanges between the parties so as to ensure

expeditious preparation for trial; and ii) to review the status of his or her case and to allow the

accused the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical

condition of the accused;

**NOTING** that the last Status Conferences in the present case took place on Friday, 19 May 2006;

CONSIDERING that it would be useful to organise another status conference in order to better

ensure the expeditious preparation for trial;

CONSIDERING that at the last Status Conference the planning for the start of the trial has been

discussed:<sup>2</sup>
