I, Carmel Agius, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

HAVING DESIGNATED MYSELF pre-trial Judge in the case of *Prosecutor v. Vujadin Popović*, *Ljubiša Beara, Drago Nikolić, Ljubomir Borovčanin, Zdravko Tolimir, Radivoje Miletić, Milan Gvero, Vinko Pandurević and Milorad Trbić*, Case No. IT-05-88-PT;¹

NOTING the Prosecution pre-trial brief ("pre-trial brief"), which was filed pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* (E) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") on 28 April 2006, together with the list of witnesses the Prosecution intends to call ("witness list"), and the list of exhibits the Prosecution intends to offer ("exhibit list") (together "respective submissions");²

NOTING Rule 65 ter (E) of the Rules which sets out the requirements for the respective submissions;

NOTING ALSO that pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* (B) of the Rules the pre-trial Judge shall take any measures necessary to prepare the case for a fair and expeditious trial;

CONSIDERING that this case has nine Accused³ and that the pre-trial Judge may therefore take such appropriate measures that may ensure a fair and expeditious trial;

CONSIDERING that the Prosecution should provide to the Trial Chamber and the Defence a proofing chart, consisting of a detailed overview about the evidence to be presented during trial, in relation to each of the paragraphs of the indictment and each of the Accused;

CONSIDERING that the proofing chart should be organised along the following lines:

(A) the paragraph of the indictment:

(1) each relevant witness, including first and last name or pseudonym, whether the witness is proposed to testify live or through Rule 89 (F) or 92 bis and estimated length of examination-in-chief, if called to testify live; and to which paragraph(s) of the pre-trial brief the witness testimony relates;

(2) each relevant exhibit, including the ERN number, a title in respect of the document's content, the name of the author of the document, the date of issuance of the document and the origin of the document, as far as these elements can be provided; and to which paragraph(s) of the pre-trial brief the exhibit relates;

(B) the Accused:

- (1) each relevant witness, including first and last name or pseudonym, whether the witness is proposed to testify live or through Rule 89 (F) or 92 *bis* and estimated length of examination-in- chief, if called to testify live; and to which paragraph(s) of the indictment and paragraph(s) of the pre-trial brief the witness testimony relates;
- (2) each relevant exhibit, including the ERN number, a title in respect of the document's content, the name of the author of the document, the date of issuance of the document and the origin of the document, as far as these elements can be provided; and to which paragraph(s) of the indictment and paragraph(s) of the pre-trial brief the exhibit relates;

CONSIDERING that the official start of trial in the present case is scheduled for 14 July 2006;⁴

PURSUANT to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDER the Prosecution to file a proofing chart as set out in this order, no later than Monday, 3 July 2006.
