**ORDER ON SCHEDULING OF TRIAL**

**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the amended Indictment against Josip Jović (“the Accused”) filed on 15 June 2006, charging the Accused with contempt of the Tribunal, punishable under the Tribunal’s inherent power, Rule 77(A) and Rule 77(A)(ii) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”),

**CONSIDERING** that Rule 77(E) of the Rules provides that the rules of procedure and evidence in Parts Four to Eight of the Rules shall apply *mutatis mutandis* in contempt proceedings,

**CONSIDERING** that all preliminary motions have been disposed of and that the case is ready to go to trial,

**NOTING** the Prosecution’s Pre-Trial Brief, filed on 15 June 2006, annexing a list of proposed witnesses and exhibits,

**CONSIDERING** that, if it has not already done so, the Prosecution should immediately furnish the Accused with copies of its proposed exhibits,

**NOTING** that the Accused has been ordered to file his pre-trial brief by 22 June 2006,

**CONSIDERING** that it is in the interests of justice and the expeditious conduct of these contempt proceedings for the Accused to file, along with his pre-trial brief: his list of proposed witnesses, identified by name or pseudonym; a summary of the facts on which each witness will testify; the points in the Indictment as to which each witness will testify; an indication of whether each witness will testify in person or pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*; the estimated length of time required for each witness; and a list of exhibits that he intends to offer, providing copies to the Prosecution of these exhibits;

**REMINDING** the Prosecution and the Defence of the need to focus their arguments and submissions at trial on the essential, disputed points of fact and law, and for their submissions to be as clear and concise as possible;


**PURSUANT TO** Rules 54, 65 *ter*, and 77 of the Rules,

**HEREBY ORDERS** as follows:

- (1) If it has not yet done so, the Prosecution shall provide immediately to the Accused copies of all proposed exhibits as listed in the annex to its Pre-Trial Brief;
- (2) The Accused shall file his list of proposed witnesses, identified by name or pseudonym; a summary of the facts on which each witness will testify; the points in the Indictment as to which each witness will testify; an indication of whether each witness will testify in person or pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*; the estimated length of time required for each witness; and a list of exhibits that he intends to offer, by 22 June 2006, and shall provide copies to the Prosecution of these exhibits by that date;
- (3) The trial in the present case shall be held on Monday, 3 July 2006, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. and continuing, should it be necessary, on Wednesday 5 July 2006, from 9:00 a.m.;
- (4) Josip Jović shall travel to The Hague to be present at the trial on 3 July 2006, and thereafter as directed by the Trial Chamber;

and **HEREBY INSTRUCTS** the Registry to make the necessary arrangements to ensure the presence of Josip Jović in the Hague on 3 July 2006, and thereafter for the period of his trial.
