# DECISION ON "APPELLANT IVICA MARIJAČIĆ'S PRECAUTIONARY REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME"

THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal" and "Appeals Chamber", respectively);

**BEING SEIZED OF** "Appellant Ivica Marijačić's Precautionary Request for Extension of Time", filed by Ivica Marijačić ("Appellant") on 16 June 2006 ("Appellant's Request for Extension of Time"), in which the Appellant requests the Appeals Chamber

- to issue a ruling that the proper briefing schedule in this case is the one outlined in Rule 111 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), or
- in the alternative, to grant the Appellant an extension of time to 23 June 2006 to file his Brief in Reply; or
- such other relief as this Trial [sic] Chamber deems appropriate;

**NOTING** the "Urgent Prosecution Motion to Strike Marijačić's Appeal Brief", filed by the Prosecution on 8 June 2006 ("Prosecution Motion to Strike"), in which the Prosecution requests the "Appellant Ivica Marijačić's Appellant's Brief", filed on 2 June 2006 ("Appellant's Brief"), to be struck, as it was filed "manifestly out of time and [without] any good cause for [t]his late filing"; <sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** "Defendant Ivica Marijačić's Response to the Prosecution's Motion to Strike Marijačić's Appeal Brief', filed on 13 June 2006, in which the Appellant requests the Appeals Chamber *inter alia* to deny the Prosecution Motion to Strike on the basis that the appropriate briefing schedule for Judgements issued pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules is the schedule provided in Rule 111 of the Rules, and not the schedule provided in Section III of the Practice Direction on Procedure for the Filing of Written Submissions in Appeal Proceedings before the International Tribunal;<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the issue whether the briefing schedule outlined in Rule 111 of the Rules is applicable in the present case is intrinsically connected with the relief sought in the Prosecution Motion to Strike on which the Appeals Chamber will decide in due course;

**CONSIDERING** that the Appellant submits in the alternative that an extension of time until 23 June 2006 to file the Brief in Reply is warranted, because counsel Marin Ivanović had been preoccupied with pressing family obligations due to the birth of his baby girl on 14 June 2006;

CONSIDERING that the Appellant has shown good cause for an extension of time to file his Brief

in Reply until 23 June 2006;

CONSIDERING that the present decision on the Appellant's Request for Extension of Time is

without prejudice to the relief sought in the Prosecution Motion to Strike;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS

ALLOWS the Appellant's Request for Extension of Time insofar as an extension of time for filing

his Brief in Reply is granted until 23 June 2006;

**DISMISSES** the remainder of the Appellant's Request for Extension of Time.
