HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Lukić shall file a reply to the Response by 23 June 2006;
- 2. the Republic of Serbia shall file a sur-reply by 30 June 2006; and
- 3. a hearing on the Motion shall be held (if necessary) on 6 July 2006.

The Chamber will make further orders in due course regarding the proposed hearing of the Motion.
