

TRIAL CHAMBER III ("Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

SEIZED of a confidential Oral Motion of 3 July 2006, in which Counsel for the Accused Jadranko Prlić ("Defence") requests the provisional release of the Accused Jadranko Prlić ("Accused Prlić") from 1 to 9 August 2006 ("Motion");

CONSIDERING the "Decision On Motion For Provisional Release of the Accused Prlić", rendered confidentially by the Chamber on 26 June 2006 ("Decision"), in which the Chamber ordered the provisional release of the Accused Prlić from 14 to 22 July 2006.

WHEREAS the Chamber is not opposed to an amendment to the dates;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

PURSUANT to rules 54 and 65 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

GRANTS the motion, and

ORDERS the provisional release of the Accused Prlić for the period of 1 to 9 August2006, subject to the same conditions set out in the Decision, and

REQUESTS the Registrar of the Tribunal to take all appropriate measures to implement this Order.
