I, MOHAMED SHAHABUDEEN, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Order Assigning Judges to a Case Before an Appeals Chamber,” filed on 14 February 2005, which, *inter alia*, designated me to serve as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

NOTING that Trial Chamber I rendered its Judgement in this case orally on 17 January 2005 and in writing on 24 January 2005 (“Judgement”);

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seised of notices of appeal filed by Vidoje Blagojević and Dragan Jokić (“Appellants”) and by the Prosecution;


NOTING that status conferences were last held for Mr. Blagojević and Mr. Jokić on 13 March 2006 and 28 April 2006, respectively;

NOTING that the Appellants are in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague during the appeals proceedings in this case, and are therefore entitled to status conferences within increments of 120 days according to Rule 65 *bis* (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

NOTING, however, that counsel to Mr. Blagojević has communicated his acceptance of a delay in his status conference so as to facilitate scheduling of a joint status conference with Mr. Jokić;

ORDER that a Status Conference for both appellants be held on 23 August 2006, at 8:00 AM, in Courtroom II of the International Tribunal.
