I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING the letter from the Secretary General dated 25 November 2005, in which Judge Frank Höpfel is appointed to serve, effective 29 November 2005, as *ad litem* Judge in the International Tribunal for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Milan Martić*, Case No. IT-95-11-PT;


NOTING Security Council Resolution 1481 (2003), which conferred *ad litem* Judges with the authority to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings in cases other than those they have been appointed to try;
