I, Krister Thelin, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the

Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

HAVING BEEN APPOINTED as pre-trial Judge in this case by virtue of the Order of Trial

Chamber III dated 16 May 2006;

NOTING Rule 65 bis(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), which states that

a "Trial Chamber or a Trial Chamber Judge shall convene a status conference within one

hundred and twenty days of the initial appearance of the accused and thereafter within one

hundred and twenty days after the last status conference";

CONSIDERING that on 4 October 2006 the Trial Chamber received a "Statement by

Counsel for Rasim Delić and by Rasim Delić in Relation to the Scheduling of a Status

Conference", dated 3 October 2006 and signed by the Accused and his Counsel, in which the

Accused agreed that the Status Conference be scheduled in the week of 13 to 17 November

2006, thus outside of the 120 day limit prescribed by Rule 65 ter of the Rules;

PURSUANT to Rules 54 and 65 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the

International Tribunal;

HEREBY SCHEDULE a status conference for Wednesday, 15 November 2006,

commencing at 8:00 a.m. in Courtroom II.
