1. At a status conference held on 1 November 2006, the Trial Chamber ordered the

removal of the Accused from the courtroom, pursuant to Rule 80 (B) of the Tribunal's Rules

of Procedure and Evidence, because he was engaging in disruptive conduct. Standby Counsel

was thereupon ordered to temporarily take over the conduct of the defence from the Accused,

in accordance with the duties of Standby Counsel as set out in the Trial Chamber's order of

25 October 2006, paragraph 5 (h).

2. As a consequence of the removal of the Accused from the courtroom, the Trial

Chamber did not have an opportunity to be informed by the Accused, among other matters,

about his preparedness to commence the trial. The measure of handing over the conduct of the

defence to Standby Counsel was of a temporary nature, and since the Accused's self-

representation is being restored as at the time of the filing of the present order, the Trial

Chamber seeks another opportunity to make inquiries of the Accused about his preparedness

to commence the trial, as well as other matters.

3. For this reason, the Trial Chamber hereby schedules a status conference, to be held on

Friday 3 November 2006, starting at 8 a.m. in courtroom II.
