I, Judge Bakone Justice Moloto, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

BEING assigned Pre-trial Judge in the present case pursuant to Rule 65*ter* of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) by Order of 16 June 2006;

BEING SEIZED of the “Prosecution’s Motion Seeking Leave to Amend the Indictment” (“Motion”), filed by the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) on 13 November 2006, in which the Prosecution seeks leave to amend the indictment against Dragomir Milošević (“Accused”), filed on 26 March 1999, in order to narrow the modes of liability, under which the Accused has been charged, and to provide a more precise, clear and succinct description of the Prosecution’s case;

NOTING the proposed amended indictment attached as Annex A and Annex B (with tracked changes) to the Motion;

CONSIDERING that counsel for the Accused (“Defence”) are entitled to file a response to the Motion pursuant to Rule 50(A)(i)(c) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), and that the Defence has a right to further challenge the form of the Amended Indictment pursuant to Rule 72(A)(ii) of the Rules;

CONSIDERING that the Prosecution should be given an opportunity to reply to the Defence’s response;

PURSUANT TO Rules 50, 72(A)(ii) and 126*bis* of the Rules

HEREBY ORDER the Defence to file a response to the Motion (including both challenges to the proposed amended indictment and challenges to its form, if any) by no later than 19 December 2006;

GRANT the Prosecution leave to file a reply to the Defence response; and


ORDER the Prosecution to file a reply, if any, no later than 29 December 2006.
