**I, FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

**NOTING** the "Order Reassigning a Case to a Trial Chamber" of 22 November 2006, which assigned this case to Trial Chamber III;

**NOTING** the letter of the Secretary-General of 14 September 2005, in which Judge Krister Thelin is appointed to serve in the International Tribunal as an *ad litem* Judge for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Mrkšić et al.*, Case No. IT-95-13/1, effective 3 October 2005;

**NOTING** the letter of the Secretary-General of 24 April 2006, in which Judge Antoine Kesia-Mbe Mindua is appointed to serve in the International Tribunal as a reserve Judge for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Prlić et al.*, Case No. IT-04-74-T, effective 25 April 2006;

**NOTING** Security Council Resolution 1481 (2003), which authorized *ad litem* Judges to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings in cases other than those they have been appointed to try;


**NOTING** that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

**CONSIDERING** the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;

**HEREBY ASSIGN**, with immediate effect, Judge Krister Thelin and Judge Antoine Kesia-Mbe Mindua to *Prosecutor v. Dragomir Milošević*, Case No. IT-98-29/1-PT, for the purposes of pre-trial work and appoint Judge Patrick Robinson as Pre-Trial Judge in this case.
