I, **KEVIN PARKER**, Vice-President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the “Order Reassigning a Case to a Trial Chamber” of 15 January 2007, which assigned this case to Trial Chamber I;

NOTING the letter of the Secretary-General of 25 November 2005, in which Judge Frank Höpfel is appointed to serve in the International Tribunal as an *ad litem* Judge for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Martić*, Case No. IT-95-11-T, effective 29 November 2005;

NOTING the letter of the Secretary-General of 11 July 2006, in which Judge Ole Bjørn Støle is appointed to serve in the International Tribunal as a reserve *ad litem* Judge for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Popović et al.*, Case No. IT-05-88-T, effective 11 July 2006;

NOTING Security Council resolution 1481 (2003), which authorizes *ad litem* Judges to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings in cases other than those they have been appointed to try;

NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”) authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;


NOTING that President Fausto Pocar is temporarily absent from the International Tribunal on Tribunal business and that pursuant to Rule 21 of the Rules, the Vice-President shall exercise the functions of the President in the case of the latter’s absence or inability to act;

CONSIDERING the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;

HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Judge Frank Höpfel and Judge Ole Bjørn Støle to *Prosecutor v. Ramush Haradinaj et al.*, Case No. IT-04-84-PT, for the purposes of pre-trial work in this case.
