

1. The Accused last attended a status conference on 8 November 2006.
2. According to Rule 65*bis* of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence "[a] Trial Chamber or a Trial Chamber Judge shall convene a status conference within one hundred and twenty days of the initial appearance of the accused and thereafter one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference: (i) to organize exchanges between the parties so as to ensure expeditious preparation for trial; (ii) to review the status of his or her case and to allow the accused the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental health and physical condition of the accused".
3. Pursuant to Rule 65*bis* of the Rules, the Trial Chamber hereby schedules a status conference, to be held on Wednesday 28 February 2007 at 9:15 a.m. in courtroom II.
