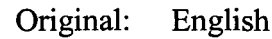

**NOTING** the certification to appeal the Decision on Form of Disclosure granted by Trial Chamber I on 22 November 2006 pursuant to Rule 73(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);

**NOTING** the “Interlocutory Appeal by Professor Vojislav Šešelj Against the Decision on Form of Disclosure Issued by Trial Chamber I on 4 July 2006” received on 6 February 2007 and filed confidentially on 14 February 2007;

**CONSIDERING** Articles 12(3) and 14(3) of the Statute of the International Tribunal and Rule 73(B) of the Rules;

**CONSIDERING** the composition of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal as set out in document IT/245 issued on 12 May 2006;
