NOTING the "Order Assigning Judges to a Case Before the Appeals Chamber and Appointing a

Pre-Appeal Judge," filed on 26 April 2006, which, inter alia, designated me to serve as Pre-Appeal

Judge in this case;

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seized of notices of appeal filed by Enver Hadžihasanović

and Amir Kubura;

NOTING that a status conference was last held for Mr. Hadžihasanović on 11 December 2006, at

which Mr. Kubura was also represented;

NOTING that although Mr. Kubura was granted early release on 11 April 2006, Mr.

Hadžihasanović is in custody at the United Nations Detention Centre and is therefore entitled to

status conferences within increments of 120 days according to Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of

Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that in order to facilitate the appeal process and in the interests of justice, it is

preferable that Mr. Kubura also be represented at this third status conference at the appeal stage;

ORDER that a Status Conference be held for both Appellants on Wednesday, 4 April 2007, at 8:00

AM, in Courtroom II of the International Tribunal.
