I, Jean-Claude Antonetti, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

NOTING the Order of the President of the Trial Chamber of 22 February 2007, assigning a Pre-Trial Judge.

CONSIDERING that pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Pre-Trial Judge shall convene a status conference at least once every one hundred and twenty days.

CONSIDERING that the next status conference shall be held on 5 June 2007 and that, during the status conference of 2 May 2007 the Pre-Trial Judge declared his intention to hold status conferences every two or three weeks with a view to preparing the trial;

PURSUANT TO Article 65 *bis* A) of the Rules,

ORDER that a status conference be held on Wednesday 4 July 2007 at 0900 hours in Courtroom 3.
