**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**BEING SEIZED OF** the appeal lodged by the Prosecution against the Judgement rendered in this case by Trial Chamber I, Section A, on 16 November 2005;

**NOTING** the notice of appeal<sup>1</sup> and the Appellant’s brief<sup>2</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 16 December 2005 and 1 March 2006, respectively, the Respondent’s brief filed by Sefer Halilović on 20 September 2006,<sup>3</sup> and the brief in reply filed by the Prosecution on 22 September 2006;<sup>4</sup>

**PURSUANT** to Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”) which provides that “[a]fter the expiry of the time-limits for filing the briefs provided for in Rules 111, 112 and 113, the Appeals Chamber shall set the date for the hearing and the Registrar shall notify the parties”;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that the hearing in the present appeal shall be held on Tuesday, 10 July 2007 and Wednesday, 11 July 2007 in Courtroom I, and **INFORMS** the parties that the timetable for the hearing shall be as follows:


