I, **THEODOR MERON**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”), and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case,

CONSIDERING that Haradin Bala is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the decision of the appeals in this case;

CONSIDERING that the last status conference took place on 21 March 2007;


CONSIDERING that Rule 65*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) of the Tribunal requires the convening of a status conference within 120 days of the last status conference to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the physical and mental condition of that person;

ORDER that a status conference shall be held before me on Monday, 9 July 2007 at 15:00hr in Courtroom 2; and

FURTHER ORDER that, pursuant to Rule 65*bis*(C) of the Rules, should Counsel for a defendant seek to participate by tele-conference rather than in person, Counsel shall file the written consent of his client to this effect at least one week prior to the status conference.
