ORDER RECALLING RASIM DELIĆ FROM PROVISIONAL RELEASE

TRIAL CHAMBER I (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

CONSIDERING the Decision on Defence Request for Provisional Release, filed on 6 May 2005, whereby the Trial Chamber set out the conditions concerning the provisional release of Rasim Delić, and ordered that Rasim Delić “return to the International Tribunal at such time and on such date as the Trial Chamber may order” and “comply strictly with any further Order of the Trial Chamber varying the terms of or terminating his provisional release”;¹

CONSIDERING that the Pre-Trial Conference in this case is scheduled to take place on 2 July 2007 and that the Opening Statement of the Prosecution is due to be given on 9 July 2007;²

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rules 54 and 65 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

ORDERS:

1. Rasim Delić to return to the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague on Monday 25 June 2007;
2. the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to designate an official who shall accompany Rasim Delić from Visoko and who shall deliver Rasim Delić into the custody of the Dutch authorities at Schiphol airport, on 25 June 2007;
3. the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to notify, as soon as practicable, the Trial Chamber and the Registrar of the Tribunal of the name of the designated official;
4. the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to ensure the personal security and safety of Rasim Delić until he is delivered into the custody of the Dutch authorities at Schiphol airport on 25 June 2007;
5. the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to ensure that Rasim Delić is transported, under guard, from Schiphol Airport to the United Nations Detention Unit;


INSTRUCTS:

1. the Registrar of the Tribunal to consult with the Ministry of Justice of the Netherlands as to the practical arrangements for Rasim Delić's return to the United Nations Detention Unit;
2. the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Registry of the Tribunal to communicate with each other in order to facilitate the orderly return of Rasim Delić to the United Nations Detention Unit;

REQUESTS the authorities of all States through whose territory Rasim Delić may travel;

1. to hold Rasim Delić in custody for any time that he will spend in transit; and
2. to arrest and detain Rasim Delić pending his return to the United Nations Detention Unit in the Hague, should he attempt to escape.
