I, Patrick Robinson, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber III of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

CONSIDERING the Third Amended Joinder Indictment against Vlastimir Đorđević (“Accused”), which was filed by the Office of the Prosecutor of the Tribunal on 6 July 2006, with the case number IT-05-87/1-I,


CONSIDERING the transfer of the Accused to the seat of the Tribunal on 17 June 2007,

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of the Accused and enjoins the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit of the Tribunal in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
