Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of the Defence "Notice of

Disclosure of Expert Report of Dr Ivica Milosavljević (Rule 94 bis) with Public Annex A", filed on

16 June 2007.

2. On 21 August 2007, the Trial Chamber issued its "Decision on Defence Experts" in which it

held that it would decide on the qualification of Ivica Milosavljević as an expert when it is provided

with the proper material that will allow it to make that determination. The Trial Chamber

inadvertently overlooked the curriculum vitae provided with the BCS version of the Report of Ivica

Milosavljević. It has now reviewed that curriculum vitae. The Trial Chamber finds that Ivica

Milosavljević meets the requisite qualifications to appear as an expert witness in the field of

forensic pathology.
