

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) is seised of “Pavković’s First Motion to Amend Rule 65 ter Exhibit List,” filed on 15 August 2007, and hereby issues this decision thereon.

1. In the Motion, the Pavković Defence seeks to add several documents to its Rule 65 *ter* exhibit list¹ on the basis that their translations have only recently been received from the Conference Language Services Section (“CLSS”) of the Registry. The Pavković Defence also informs the Chamber that additional documents remain pending with CLSS and that others have only recently been produced by the Republic Serbia and will be submitted to CLSS in the near future for translation.
2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to oppose the Motion.
3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion.
