Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of "General Pavković's Second Motion

to Amend Rule 65ter Exhibit List," filed 25 September 2007, and hereby issues this decision

thereon.

Conference and Language Services Section ("CLSS") of the Registry. The Pavković Defence also

only recently been produced by the Republic of Serbia and may be submitted to CLSS in the near

future for translation.

2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to oppose the Motion.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 65 ter of the Rules of Procedure

and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion.
