**NOTING** the "Scheduling order and incorporated order suspending provisional release", filed on 10 October 2007 ("Scheduling Order"), which suspended the provisional release of the Accused Ivan Čermak and the Accused Mladen Markač for the purposes of attending the status conference held in this case on Friday 26 October 2007;

**PURSUANT TO** Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 65 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

**ORDERS** the provisional release of the Accused Ivan Čermak and the Accused Mladen Markač be reinstated as of Saturday 27 October 2007 under the same conditions as applicable to each Accused prior to the suspension of their provisional release by the Scheduling Order;

**ORDERS** the Registry of the Tribunal to consult the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands ("Netherlands") and the Government of the Republic of Croatia ("Croatia") as to the practical arrangements for the provisional release of the Accused;

**ORDERS** the Government of the Netherlands to ensure that each Accused is transported, under guard, from the United Nations Detention Unit to Schiphol Airport or any other airport in the Netherlands, and released into the custody of designated officials of the Government of Croatia;
