THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that Dragan Jokić (“Jokić”) was issued a subpoena to appear before the Trial Chamber to give oral testimony in *Prosecutor v. Popović et al.*;¹

NOTING that Jokić refused to testify before the Trial Chamber on 31 October and 1 November 2007;²


NOTING the “Order In Lieu of Indictment on Contempt Concerning Dragan Jokić” issued on 1 November 2007, in which the Trial Chamber determined that it has reason to believe that Jokić may be in contempt of the Tribunal and decided, pursuant to Rule 77(D)(ii) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), “to prosecute the matter itself”;

CONSIDERING that in accordance with Rule 77(E) Parts Four to Eight of the Rules shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the contempt proceedings;

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules,

HEREBY ORDERS that Dragan Jokić appear before the Trial Chamber on 19 November 2007, at 14:15 hours.
