ORDER FOR DETENTION ON REMAND

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the indictment against Ljube Krstevski submitted by the Prosecution and confirmed by Judge Bakone Justice Moloto in the confidential decision of 30 October 2007;¹

CONSIDERING that the Accused was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 28 November 2007;

NOTING the Order filed on 29 November 2007 by the President of Trial Chamber II assigning the case against Ljube Krstevski to this Trial Chamber;²

NOTING the Order of Judge Agius issued on 29 November 2007 designating Judge Krister Thelin as Judge of Trial Chamber II for the initial appearance of Ljube Krstevski;

NOTING the Scheduling Order issued by Judge Thelin on 29 November 2007 scheduling the initial appearance of Ljube Krstevski for 1415 hours on 29 November 2007;

NOTING the Order issued by Judge Agius on 29 November 2007 ordering that the trial bench in the case of *Prosecutor v Ljube Krstevski* should be composed of Judge Kevin Parker (presiding), Judge Christine Van Den Wyngaert and Judge Krister Thelin;

CONSIDERING that at the initial appearance the Prosecution moved orally for leave to withdraw the indictment against Ljube Krstevski;

CONSIDERING that during the initial appearance the Prosecution and Counsel for Ljube Krstevski were ordered to file written submissions on the matter by 3 and 6 December 2007, respectively, and that the Trial Chamber is to decide on this matter;

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of the Accused and instruct the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
