NOTING the Order issued confidentially on 29 November 2007 by the Vice-President of the Tribunal, assigning the case against Ljube Krstevski to Trial Chamber II;

NOTING my order dated 29 November 2007 designating Judge Krister Thelin as Judge of Trial Chamber II for the initial appearance of Ljube Krstevski;

CONSIDERING that it is in the interests of justice and of an expeditious trial to assign the case of *Prosecutor v. Ljube Krstevski*, Case No: IT-04-82-R77.1 to a bench for trial;
