**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Appeals Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively),

**NOTING** the "Appeal by Momčilo Krajišnik to the ICTY Judgement of 27 September 2006" ("Appeal Brief"), submitted on 29 October 2007;<sup>1</sup>

**RECALLING** the Appeals Chamber's Decision of 18 October 2007<sup>2</sup> in which it denied a request by Mr. Momčilo Krajišnik ("Mr. Krajišnik") for an extension of the applicable word limit for his Appeal Brief from 30,000 words to 45,000 words;

**CONSIDERING** that although Mr. Krajišnik did not note the precise word count of his Appeal Brief, the Appeal Brief appears to exceed 40,000 words in length;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that Mr. Krajišnik, within fourteen days of his receiving a BCS translation of this order, re-submit confidential and public versions of his Appeal Brief, each of which shall explicitly note the word count and neither of which shall exceed 30,000 words in length.
