ORDER WITH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION FROM THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA

I, Judge Krister Thelin, Pre-Trial Judge in the case *Prosecutor v. Mićo Stanišić* at the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"), ¹

NOTING the "Decision on Mićo Stanišić's Motion for Provisional Release" issued by Trial Chamber II of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia ("Trial Chamber"), on 19 July 2005 ("Decision");²

NOTING, that in the Decision, which allows Mićo Stanišić ("Accused") to provisionally reside in his home in Belgrade and "to return to the Tribunal at such time and on such date as the Tribunal may order", the Trial Chamber *inter alia* ordered the Accused's strict compliance with the terms set out in the Decision, and required the government of the Republic of Serbia to assume a number of responsibilities in respect of the Accused's provisional release;

NOTING, that amongst these responsibilities, the government of the Republic of Serbia was required to submit written reports on the Accused's compliance with the terms of the Decision on a monthly basis;

NOTING, further, that the Trial Chamber, which previously had received timely monthly reports, did not receive any reports for the months of June, July, August, September and October 2007;

NOTING that the Trial Chamber, through its Senior Legal Officer in a letter of 2 November 2007, requested, that the Government of the Republic of Serbia submit by 16 November 2007 "a written report as to the compliance of Mr. Mićo Stanišić with the terms of the Decision together with an explanation of its failure to have done so on a monthly basis during the period since 17 May 2007";³

NOTING, finally, that on 13 November 2007 the Trial Chamber received a report, similar to those previously received, from the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia, informing the Trial Chamber that the Accused and the authorities of the Republic of Serbia have fully complied with the conditions set out in the Decision "in the last reporting period", but that no reference was made to the request for information of 2 November 2007, and no further information was provided to the Trial Chamber in this communication;

CONSIDERING the need to have full clarity regarding the Accused's compliance with the

conditions for provisional release, pursuant to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of

the Tribunal, hereby REQUEST the Republic of Serbia, by and no later than 31 December 2007,

to:

(a) provide the Trial Chamber with an explanation as to why the Republic of Serbia has failed to

submit its monthly reports for the period running from June to October 2007, and

(b) submit to the Trial Chamber, a full report for the period from June 2007 until the current date

on the Accused's compliance with the terms of the Decision.
