THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of the "Sreten Lukić's Request Regarding Exhibit 6D117," filed on 5 December 2007, and "Sreten Lukić's Request Regarding

Exhibit 6D988," filed on 6 December 2007, and hereby issues this order thereon.

1. On 17 October 2007, exhibit 6D117 was marked for identification pending translation. On 11 September 2007, exhibit 6D988 was marked for identification pending translation. The Lukić Defence informs the parties and the Trial Chamber that both exhibits 6D117 and 6D988 have been translated and the translations have been uploaded to eCourt, and requests that both exhibits and

their translations be admitted into evidence.

2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to oppose the Motion.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motions and ORDERS that exhibits 6D117 and 6D988 along with their translations shall be admitted into evidence.
