CONSIDERING that it would be appropriate for the Defence to file a response, if any, as soon as

possible so as to enable a decision on the Motion in good time;

PURSUANT to Rules 54, 126 bis and 127 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDERS the Defence to file a Response to the Motion, if any, before 1200 hours on

Monday, 14 January 2008.
