THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of "Vladimir Lazarević's Sixth Motion

to Amend Rule 65ter Exhibit List," filed 16 January 2008 ("Motion"), and hereby issues this

decision thereon.

1. In the Motion, the Lazarević Defence seeks to add documents to its Rule 65 ter exhibit list¹

on the basis that they were provided only recently by the witness Milan Kotur during his proofing.

The Lazarević Defence argues that the documents are relevant to the trial and indispensable for the

presentation of the defence case and that their addition to the list would serve the interests of

justice.

2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to oppose the Motion.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 65 ter of the Rules of Procedure

and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion.
